Community and School Service Hours

All NHS members are required to complete 15 community service hours and 15 school service hours by the end of the 18-19 school year. The examples and expectations are listed on the service hour forms.

Grade Point Average

Members must maintain a cumilative GPA of 3.5 or 90%. Grades are checked at the end of first semester and second semester

Service Learning Project

The Homer NHS Chapter is required to perform a service learning project each school year. We will discuss at the October meeting ideas and projects the group would like to do.

Character

Conduct and behavior

a. The student must demonstrate an outstanding record of conduct and behavior with regard to school and community rules, regulations, guidelines, and policies or has been able to demonstrate sufficient growth and improvement to compensate for previous inadequacies. Students who have previously been arrested and/or found guilty of civil offenses will not automatically be excluded from consideration into membership though such actions are taken seriously as part of the selection process.

b. Documentation including administrative records, counseling records, conduct and behavior reviews and consolation with the School Resource Officer is considered credible background character references in the selection process. Discipline records describing violations of the Homer Community School drug, alcohol, and activity policies, pre-sentence investigations by the court system or diversion programs may be used in the final selection determination.
